Funds approved unanimously

Ms. Molly O'Brien requests up to \$1000 for AP Calculus Camp, a weekend retreat to prepare for May exam. The goal is to make the camp experience affordable for as many as students as possible. A total cost of \$6-7000 is anticipated. Last year some parents and an Assistant Principal made up the difference. Last year 40 students participated and paid half the cost, \$50 each plus 2 teachers were paid for and a retired engineer/ Hamilton alumnus who tutors the students. This covered 2 nights stay and 5 meals. The bus was provided. The Kobe Ranch where they stayed last year is unavailable this year so a different location is being sought.
